



Notice to Amateur Radio Licence Holders

ComReg reminds all amateur radio licence holders of their obligation, under the conditions of their licence, to confirm that their licence details remain correct every five years.

See Regulation 7(1)(i) of [S.I. No. 192/2009 - Wireless Telegraphy \(Amateur Station Licence\) Regulations 2009](#)

Failure to complete this mandatory 5-year confirmation may result in the cancellation of your licence.

ComReg will be issuing formal notification letters by post to licence holders with overdue confirmations. These letters will outline:

- The date by which confirmation was due;
- The proposed cancellation date of the licence; and
- Instructions on how to maintain an active licence.

If you believe your licence confirmation may be overdue, you are strongly advised to file your return as soon as possible through www.licensing.comreg.ie, or alternatively contact the ComReg Licensing Team immediately at licensing@comreg.ie
